

## COLLIN COLLEGE ART SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION 2009 – 2010 Academic Year

In order to be considered, applicants will be expected to adhere to the following guidelines:

Scholarship recipients **MUST** be a declared Visual Art major.

Scholarship recipients **MUST** maintain a full-time academic load of twelve (12) hours per semester at Collin and earn a minimum 2.5 GPA during the semester in which the scholarship is awarded

Scholarship recipients **MUST** be enrolled in at least one 3 credit hour Visual Art course during the semester in which the scholarship is awarded

Scholarship recipients **MUST** exhibit work in the Creative Components Student show during the semester the scholarship is awarded. In addition, the student will be invited to exhibit prior portfolio works in the Art Department Scholarship Award Show, to be held during the 2008 Fall Semester

Scholarship credits will be awarded at the reception for this event.

Scholarship recipients **MUST** adhere to the Student Code of Conduct as printed in the Collin College Student Handbook

Applicants **MUST** follow all submission requirements as noted on the Scholarship Application

Any exception to the above **MUST** be cleared in advance by the Chair of the Art Department.

**Students who fail to meet the requirements stated above may be ineligible for future scholarship consideration.**

In order to be considered for the Collin College Art Scholarship, students must print, complete and return this form along with a CD of JPEG images of 5 – 10 works.

Applicants need to adhere to the following submission guidelines in order to be considered:

- CDs must be clearly labeled with applicant's full name
- All images need to be in JPEG format. Applicants should NOT submit prints of images, PowerPoint presentations, or actual artwork.
- JPEG images must not exceed 1200 pixels on the longest side.
- Files must be titled with the applicant's first initial, last name, and title of the work:
