**These courses must be completed within 5 years of application deadline and with a 2.5 GPA.

Candidates for admission are required to:

1. Submit the application form with **official** transcripts from **each** college or university attended; official copies of the transcript must be provided to the Admissions Office and to the Director of the Associate Degree Nursing Program. If the Admissions Office has your transcripts on file, request that copies be sent to the Director of Nursing.
2. Submit CCCC application to the Admissions Office if not currently enrolled in any course at CCCC. Information on necessary requirements for college admission or advising on previously completed college work will be assessed by Student Services. Any pre-requisite courses from other colleges and/or universities must be evaluated for equivalency by Student Services.
3. Complete the **PSB** – Nursing School Aptitude Examination prior to deadline on one of the scheduled dates and times. This test is given only a limited number of times in a designated classroom at the Central Park Campus from. Students (applicant ready) seeking admission for the next academic year must complete the test on one of the assigned dates. “Applicant Ready” means that the student will have met the admission requirements for consideration. Students have one opportunity to take the exam within a 12 month time frame. A fee of \$15.00 must be paid at the Cashier’s office at the Central Park Campus. Then the receipt is brought either to the Nursing Department (B336) or the Division Office (E302) to register for the exam. Registration will close the Friday before each exam or when full. Because seating is limited, you are advised to register early. For exam dates and further information, see **PSB exam** or call the Division Office 972-548-6679.
