**Distance Learning Re-Entry Nurse Student Eligibility Checklist**

This checklist is designed to assist the student in preparation for the Distance Learning Re-Entry Nursing Update course. Many of the requirements on the list are required for the student to participate in a clinical placement (preceptorship) coordinated by host site (CCCCD). **This is only a checklist...students will have to show proof of documentation where indicated.** At all times, information collected on students for this purpose is kept confidential and managed in accordance with HIPPA guidelines. Original copies are required on all signature sheets.

**Texas Nursing License** – Current or temporary license – Licensing information will be verified with the Board of Nurse Examiners. Failure to report stipulations can prevent clinical placement. Exp. Date \_\_\_\_\_

**Healthcare Provider CPR** – Student must be current (within 2 years of last course)  
Provide copy of your card.

**Hepatitis B Vaccine** – A current Hep B vaccine includes having completed the series of three (3) Hep B vaccine injections within the last 10 years, or receiving a Hep B blood titer showing sufficient immunity (this is non-negotiable).

**Tuberculosis Test** – A TB skin test taken within the past one-year period, with a negative result. Those who have a past positive PPD must have a current negative Chest x-ray or produce explanation of prophylactic therapy.

**Other Immunizations**, current in the following:

Diphtheria/Tetanus (TDaP) within  
last 10 years

Measles/Mumps/Rubella  
(MMR) if born after 1/1/57

Chickenpox (Varicella) or  
titer

Hepatitis A  
(waiver available)

**Background Check & Drug Testing** – Student must submit to both a Background Check and Drug Testing provided by the college. Consent forms will be provided from CCCCCD for both Background Checks and Drug Testing closer to the beginning of the course. The student will be responsible for having the Drug Testing done on the day designated by CCCCCD at a designated site. **(Failure to successfully complete both will disqualify a student from participating in the clinical component of the refresher course and therefore make the student ineligible for completing the course.)**
